1. Resolution 2012-77 – Acceptance of the proposed agenda

It is proposed by Councillor Bruce MacNab, and seconded by Councillor Marc Fredette, and it is adopted unanimously by the present members:

2. <u>Resolution 2012-72- Acceptance of the minutes of regular meeting of Septembre 8, 2012</u>

Considering that a copy of the Minutes was given to each member of the Town Council not less than twenty-four hours before the present council, this conforming to Article 333 of the Cities and Towns Act,

It is proposed by Councillor Jean Dubois, and seconded by Councillor Laurent Barbé, and it is adopted unanimously by the present members:

3. Current Affairs

3.1.Announcements

Mayor Luc Trépanier explains the 120 kV Grand Brûlé-Saint-Sauveur deviation power line project by Hydro-Quebec, located on the territory of the MRC des Pays-d'en-Haut and the MRC des Laurentides. Part of the territory of Barkmere is located in the study area. One of the proposed projects is to build the line next to the existing 735kV line. The Town of Barkmere will ensure that the proposed work is performed in accordance with the environment so as not to impair further the main tributary of the lake.

He also expresses that a pertussis epidemic is currently raging in the region. This disease mainly affects children. According to the authorities, there are ten times more cases than last year. He therefore urges the citizens not to hesitate to contact the CLSC in doubt.

3.2. Correspondence

Letter received from the MRC des Laurentides about the non-adoption by the Town of a concordance bylaw regarding telecommunication antennas. On recommendations of our planning consultant, the Town has not adopted such a regulation, the means used by the MRC to regulate antennas have been considered questionable by the expert, not to mention that it is a subject of federal jurisdiction. The Town will normalize its position beside the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.

3.3.<u>BLPA</u>

Brenda Bartlett is present and explains the major issues of the APLE: - the extension of Duncan Road. A fundraiser is underway and the results are very satisfactory. Their attorneys believe they have a good case, particularly on the subject of the protection of the environment;

3.4. Follow up from previous council meeting

Mr. Dave Williams Roy began full time on Sept. 18. He is very enthusiastic about his new job.

Regarding the park, the lease was signed with Maison de l'Immaculée Conception (the Jesuits);

A meeting was held about a local forest farm project presented by Gilles Séguin of the MRC des Laurentides. The project is at an embryonic stage. One prospective partner, Fermes Morgane, have not yet been informed of this project. More information to follow.

It also emphasizes the auditor's statement about the excellent work done by the Mayor Luc Trépanier about the transition from the old accounting system to a new computerized system.

4.5 <u>Resolution 2012-80 - Appointment of the auditor for 2012 and 2013</u>

Considering that it is required to appoint an Auditor for financial years 2012 and 2013;

Therefore, Councillor Marc Fredette moved, Councillor Bruce MacNab seconded, and it was unanimously resolved by all present:

That the Town of Barkmere appoint André Charest C.P.A. as Auditor for financial years 2012 and 2013.

5.1. Report from the Environmental consulting committee

Councillor Jean Dubois files the CEC report, and highlights the recommendations contained therein, to the effect that blue extruded polystyrene is acceptable as a means of floatation for floating docks;

6. Public services

6.1. Waste management

6.1.1. <u>Resolution 2012-81 - Agreement relating to the management of Bylaw 271-</u> 2012 relating to the collect, transport and disposal of waste

Considering that the MRC des Laurentides adopted Bylaw 271-2012 relating to the collection, transportation and disposal of waste by which it has revised all applicable regulations in this field;

Whereas under this Bylaw, it is necessary to conclude an agreement with the MRC des Laurentides to enforce various administrative and operational provisions by an employee of the town designated for this purpose;

Considering that the Town has the financial and human resources to ensure such management;

Therefore, Councillor Jean Dubois moved, Councillor Marc Fredette seconded, and it was unanimously resolved by all present:

That the Town of Barkmere accept the agreement relating to the management of Bylaw 271-2012 relating to the collect, transport and disposal of waste proposed by

the MRC des Laurentides;

That the Town of Barkmere designate the director general as the municipal officer with the MRC des Laurentides

That the Mayor and the Director General be authorized to sign said agreement on behalf of the Town.

6.1.2 <u>Resolution 2012-82 – Establishment of a door to door collection service and the purchase of bins</u>

Considering that the Town is a beneficiary of the contract for the collection, transportation and disposal of waste between the MRC des Laurentides and RC Miller;

Considering that under this contract it is possible for the Town to opt for the door to door collection service;

Considering the desire of the Town to provide this service on Barkmere, Heidi and Florestine roads;

Considering that adherence to this service creates no additional expense to that already provided in the contract, in addition to the purchase of containers;

Therefore, Councillor Laurent Barbé moved, Councillor Jean Dubois seconded, and it was unanimously resolved by all present:

That the Town of Barkmere opt to provide door to door collection service for 2013 on Barkmere, Heidi and Florestine roads;

That the Town of Barkmere buy 35 pairs of bins, for an amount not exceeding the sum of \$ 4,500;

That this expenditure be paid out of the unaffected surplus;

That a copy of this resolution be sent to the MRC des Laurentides;

7. <u>R.C.M. and government affair</u> 7.1.<u>Mayor's report</u>

Mayor Luc Trépanier explains that at the last council of mayors, administrative decisions were mainly at the agenda. However, the assessment roll for 2013-2014-2015 has been filed. An explanatory leaflet will be distributed and maybe a public information session will be held. The average value of properties in the territory of Barkmere has increased by 1%.

Also, the MRC will recommend to the MRNF to sale certain intramunicipal public lands under its management. Theses lots are landlocked and non-usable.

7.2. <u>Resolution 2012-83 - Appointment of a representative for the Council of Mayors of the MRC des Laurentides of October 18, 2012</u>

Considering that neither the mayor nor the pro mayor can attend the next Council of Mayors of the MRC des Laurentides of October 18, 2012;

Therefore, Councillor Laurent Barbé moved, Councillor Jean Dubois seconded, and it was unanimously resolved by all present:

That the Town of Barkmere appoint Councillor Marc Fredette as the authorized representative to serve on the Council of Mayors of the MRC des Laurentides of October 18, 2012;
