REGULATION NO. 252 RELATING TREATMENT OF MUNICIPAL ELECTS

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given by the undersigned, Director General and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Barkmere,

**THAT** at the regular meeting of the Town of Barkmere, on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the draft by-law entitled "By-law regarding the treatment of elected municipal officers" was presented and a notice of motion was given to its adoption at a subsequent meeting of the Council of the Town of Barkmere, which is proposed to be on Regular meeting of the municipal council of the Town of Barkmere scheduled on January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 10h00 am at the Community Center, 199, Barkmere Road .

This draft regulation provides :

- That the Mayor's annual base salary, which was \$ 1 470,00 will be maintained at this same amount;
- That the annual base salary of a councillor, which was \$490,00 per year will be maintained at the same amount;
- That each council member will continue to receive, in addition to the above remuneration, an allowance of expenses equal to half of the remuneration prescribed by law.

- That the future allowance will be subject to be adjusted on the manner provides in the by-law to annul the effect of taxation from any government.
- The by-law will have retrocative effect as January 1st , 2018.
