#### 4.2 <u>RESOLUTION 2019-005 – Adoption by-law 252 Remuneration of elected officers.</u>

- **WHEREAS** the Act respecting the remuneration of elected municipal officers (CQLR c. T-11.001), which determines the powers of Council on matter of fixing the remuneration of elected municipal officers;
- WHEREAS that the Town of Barkmere did not establish the remuneration of its elected officers by means of a bylaw, but was conforming to the municipal remuneration stated by this Act;
- WHEREAS this Act was amended in several ways by the Act mainly to recognize that municipalities are local governments and to increase their autonomy and powers (SQ 2017, c. 13) and by the Act to amend various legislative provisions concerning municipal affairs and the Société d'habitation du Québec (SQ 2018, c. 8);
- **WHEREAS** following these amendments, the Act does not fix a minimal remuneration for elected municipal officers, and that the Town must now proceed with a bylaw;
- **WHEREAS** article 2 of the *Act respecting the remuneration of elected municipal officers*, such bylaw can be retroactive to January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of its enaction;
- **WHEREAS** a notice of motion was given during the meeting of the Municipal Council on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and the draft bylaw was presented;

It is proposed by Councillor Jake Michael Chadwick, seconded by Councillor Stephen Lloyd and it is resolved unanimously by the members present:

**THAT** The Municipal Council of the Town of Barkmere adopts bylaw 252 on the remuneration of elected municipal officers.

#### 4.3 <u>RESOLUTION 2019-006 - BY-LAW 254 - establishing general and special taxes</u> rates for the Town of Barkmere for the year 2019

**Considering that** article 485 of the *Cities and Towns Act* (L.R.Q. c.C-19) authorizes the Town of Barkmere to impose a general tax levy on the value of the properties located on its territory;

**Considering that** article 487 of the *Cities and Towns Act* authorizes the Town of Barkmere to impose special tax levies on the value of properties located in a specific sector of its territory, namely for maintenance works;

**Considering that** article 252 of the Act respecting Municipal Taxation (RSQ, c.F-2.1) authorizes the Town of Barkmere to collect the taxes with more than one installment;

**Considering that** article 480 of the *Cities and Towns Act* authorizes the Town of Barkmere to impose an additional levy not in excess of 10% of the total amount of the collectable taxes, to compensate for recovery fees;

**Considering that** article 244.1 of the Act respecting Municipal Taxation which authorizes municipalities to provide that a tariff be established to finance its property, services and activities;

**Considering that** article 481 of the *Cities and Towns Act* authorizes the Town of Barkmere to charge interest on the balance of unpaid taxes after their due date;

**Considering that** a Notice of Motion was given by Councillor Marc Frédette at a regular meeting of the Council held on December 8, 2018;

It is proposed by Councillor Jake Michael Chadwick, seconded by Councillor Chantal Raymond, and it is resolved unanimously by the members present:

**THAT** The Municipal Council of the Town of Barkmere adopts bylaw 254 establishing general and special taxes rates for the Town of Barkmere for the year 2019.

**Accordingly,** it is ordered and ruled by this resolution that bylaw 254 establishing the general and special tax rates for the Town of Barkmere for fiscal year 2019 be adopted.

#### 4.4 <u>RESOLUTION 2019-007 – Appointment of external auditor</u>

**CONSIDERING THAT** as per section 108 of the Cities and Town Act it is required to appoint an Auditor for at least three years;

# THEREFORE,

Councellor Stephen Lloyd moved Councellor Chantal Raymond seconded, and it was unanimously resolved by all present:

**THAT** the Town of Barkmere appoint André Charest C.P.A. as Auditor for financial years 2018, 2019 et 2020;

#### AND

**TO AUTHORIZE** the Director General to sign documents to confirm this appointment.

# 4.5 RESOLUTION 2019-008 – Undertaking required by FARPCNQ

- **WHEREAS** the city of Barkmere proceeded to hire the notary Martin Paul Gélinas, who is employed exclusively by the Town of Barkmere;
- **WHEREAS** under the FARPCNQ insurance program, a notary who works exclusively for the Town of Barkmere may, according to certain requirements, benefit from class B and thus be exempted from payment of the insurance premium;
- **WHEREAS** the Town of Barkmere intends to respect the said requirements as required by FARPCNQ so that Mtre. Martin Paul Gélinas, can benefit from class B and thus benefit from an exemption from the payment of the insurance premium:

Councillor Jake Michael Chadwick moved,

Councillor Chantal Raymond seconded,

and it was unanimously resolved by all present that The Town of Barkmere:

a) guarantees undertakes to take up the cause, to answer financially for the consequences of any error or omission of Me Martin Paul Gélinas, notary, in the exercise of its functions, and to compensate the FARPCNQ for any disbursements or any compensation he would have to pay as a result of an error or omission of this notary in the performance of his duties even beyond the end of the employment relationship;

b) Waive all recourse proceedings against this notary and against the Chambre des notaires du Québec as insurer out of the assets held specifically for this purpose at the FARPCNQ, among other things, in favor of the Chambre des notaires du Québec and the FARPCNQ; and,

c) authorize Mayor Luc Trépanier, to sign and sign for the Town of Barkmere, and on his behalf, if applicable, any deed, document, writing, contract or undertaking, if any, to give effect to this resolution in order to link the City of Barkmere.

# 5.1 <u>RESOLUTION 2019-009 – Application for Financial Assistance under the aquatic Invasive plants Control Program of Fondation de la Faune du Québec - Appointment of signatory</u>

**WHEREAS** the financial assistance program for the fight against aquatic invasive alien plants set up by the Fondation de la Faune du Québec;

WHEREAS the Town of Barkmere is eligible to apply for assistance under this program;
