« Pursuant to section 356 of the Act cited and cities, notice of motion is given by Councillor Stephen Lloyd that at a subsequent council meeting by-law #291 amending by-law #205 establishing the Consultative Committee on Urbanism will be adopted.

The Mayor submits a copy of the draft by-law.

The purpose of these regulations is to:

- clarify the appointment and roles of the President and vice-President of the CCU;
- add a provision for the participation of applicants at a CCU meeting;
- add a provision authorizing CCU meetings by video-conference;
- add a provision concerning training for CCU members.

The draft is available at this meeting for consultation by citizens."
