

# First draft bylaw #293 amending zoning bylaw #201 to prohibit the construction of a boathouse on the territory of the Town of Barkmere

### Article 1. - Repeal of paragraph 2 of article 7.4.2

Paragraph 2 of article 7.4.2 entitled "Provisions relating to the littoral" is repealed.

#### Article 2. - Amendments to article 7.4.3

- **2.1** Article 7.4.3 entitled: "Special provisions for docks" is amended by replacing the text of paragraph 1. of this article by the following text:
- "1. Only one dock per lot is authorized when the lot frontage complies with urban planning regulations."
- **2.2** Article 7.4.3 entitled: "Special provisions for docks" is amended by replacing the text of paragraph 5. of this article by the following text:
- "5. In addition to the dimensions set out in paragraphs 4 and 6 of this article, no maximum surface area or maximum length applies to a dock. However, any extension of such a dock beyond the point that is 15 metres from the high-water line is limited in width (i.e. the side that is parallel to the high-water line) to 3 metres and, for safety reasons, must be equipped with reflectors on all sides, with maximum spaces of 3 metres between reflectors."
- **2.3** Article 7.4.3 entitled: "Special provisions for docks" is amended by replacing the text of paragraph 6. of this article by the following text:
- " 6. The maximum surface area of a dock is 60 square meters."

## Article 3. - Repeal of article 7.4.5

Article 7.4.5 entitled "Special provisions for boathouses" is repealed.

#### Article 4 - Modification of article 7.4.6

Article 7.4.6 entitled: "Provisions relating to Town Landing Wharves" is amended by replacing the text of paragraph 1. of this article with the following text:

"1. There is no limitation as to the number and dimensions of docks."

# Article 5 - Entry into force

The present by-law will come into force and effect once the formalities laid down in the Act have been completed.
