Positioning of bins

- Place bins at the curb the night before collection
- Place bins with 60 cm (2 ft) of clearance around each bin, handles facing the property
- In winter, clear snow and ice from the lid
- Return bins to the property promptly after collection



HOME COMPOSTING

ORGANIC WASTE



FOOD WASTE

- Fruits and vegetables (and their peels)
- Bread, pasta, and rice (without sauce, oil or fat)
- Egg shells (ideally crushed)
- Coffee grounds
- House plants (and soil)
- Coffee filters : tea and herbal tea bags



IN THE HOUSE

- Dead plants and dried flowers (without the pot)
- Shredded newspaper



IN THE GARDEN

- Grass clippings (small amounts)
- Garden waste
- Wilted flowers
- Leaves, straw, and hay (dry and in small amounts)
- Wood chips
- Soil



Do not put meat, fish or bones.
This will attract animals.

Feed your composter with green waste (leftovers, vegetables and fruits, grass clippings, green plants, etc.) and brown waste (dead leaves, coffee grounds, brown paper, etc.).

For good composting,
aerate every 2 weeks and moisten if too dry.
The compost is ready when it's dark and textured like soil.
